

How to pair up your Bluetooth® Headset

With a Bluetooth Headset from Verizon Wireless, you can stay in touch with everyone on your list – wirelessly.

How Does It Work?

Setting up a Bluetooth wireless connection for the first time between Bluetooth capable devices is called pairing (sometimes referred to as bonding).

For Verizon Wireless' devices, all Bluetooth accessories must go through a pairing process with the handset before they can be used. Once a Bluetooth accessory has been paired with the handset the first time, re-pairing is not required for continued use.

During the pairing process, the user is prompted to enter a passkey in their device. The passkey entered in the handset must match the passkey entered in the accessory. Accessories such as headsets that do not have a user interface to enter a passkey typically use a default passkey of "0000".

What will you need to pair your new device?

Before you begin to pair your new Bluetooth Headset with your handset you will need to take the following steps.

STEP 1: Charge your new Bluetooth headset. (Charging will take approximately 2-4 hours.)

STEP 2: Go to [Handset Pairing Guide](#). Choose your phone model.

STEP 3: Go to [Headset Pairing Guide](#). Choose your headset model.

STEP 4: Follow instructions provided on each guide to pair devices.

1. Press the **Menu** button.
 2. Select **Settings** and press **OK**.
 3. Select **Connection** and press **OK**.
 4. Press **OK** to select Bluetooth link.
 5. Select **Setup** and press **OK**.
 6. Select **Power** and press **OK**.
 7. Make sure **ON** is highlighted and press **OK**.
 8. Press **Back** to return to Bluetooth link screen.
 9. Select Handsfree and press **OK**.

10. Continuing on handset, select Look for Devices and press **OK**.
 11. Highlight the device name and press **Select**.

6. Select **Search** and press **OK**.
7. Select **Audible device** and press **OK**.
8. From the list of available devices, select the desired Bluetooth device and press **OK** to connect.
9. Enter passkey of **0000** and press **OK**.

BlackBerry 7250™, 7130e™, and 8703e™

1. From the home screen, select **Options** (**7130e** select **Settings**).
2. Scroll to **Bluetooth** and press in on the trackwheel.
3. If the Bluetooth Options screen displays Bluetooth: Disabled, press in on the trackwheel and select **Enable Bluetooth**.
4. On the Paired Devices: screen, press in on the trackwheel and select **Add Device**. The handset should say: Searching for devices...

NOTE: Refer to your [Bluetooth Headset Pairing Guide](#) and begin headset instructions.

5. In the Select Device: screen, the headset name (name of the headset being paired) should be highlighted, press in on the trackwheel to select.
6. When prompted, enter the default passkey of **0000**, and press the **Enter** key.
7. Press the **Escape key** (the button below the trackwheel), twice to return to the home screen.

Samsung SCH-i730 and SCH-i830/ Verizon Wireless XV6700/ Palm® Treo™ 700w Smartphone

1. Tap **Start > Settings**.
 2. On the **Connections** tab, tap **Bluetooth**.
 3. On the Mode tab, ensure the **Turn on Bluetooth** option is checked.
 4. On the Devices tab, tap **New (Partnership)**.
- NOTE: Refer to your [Bluetooth Headset Pairing Guide](#) and begin headset instructions.*
5. Continuing on handset, select the desired headset device, and then tap **Next**.
 6. Enter Passkey (0000), tap **Next**.
 7. Enter the desired Display Name then check Hands Free. Tap **Finish**.

*NOTE: SCH-i730/i830 models you will select **Next** after Passkey. The Bluetooth Active Sync window will appear prompting to setup a partnership, tap **No**. Tap **Finish**.*

1. Press on the **Home** button until **ALL** appears in the upper right corner.
2. Locate and tap **Bluetooth** icon.
3. If the display indicated that Bluetooth is off, turn it on by tapping **ON** then tap **Setup Devices**.

NOTE: Refer to your [Bluetooth Headset Pairing Guide](#) and begin instructions.

4. Continuing on the handset, tap **Hands-free Setup**. Tap **Next**.
5. From the list of available devices found, select your headset device and tap **OK** to pair.
6. Enter the PassKey (**0000**). Tap **OK**.
7. The connection between the handset and handsfree device is complete. Tap **Done**.

1. Tap the **Bluetooth** icon (lower-right corner of the display) and select **Bluetooth Manager**.
2. Tap **New** (lower-left corner of display).
3. Ensure **Hands-free/Headset setup** is selected then tap **Next**.
4. Tap **Next**.

NOTE: Refer to your [Bluetooth Headset Pairing Guide](#) and begin headset instructions.

5. Continuing on handset, Selected the desired device then tap **Next**.
6. Enter Passkey (**0000**), tap **OK** then tap **Finish**.

1. Press the **left soft key** to choose **Start**.
2. Select **Bluetooth** then press in on the trackwheel.
3. Select **Bluetooth Manager** then press in on the trackwheel.
4. Select Settings then press in on the trackwheel.
5. Change the Status to **ON** by using the left / right of the 5-way navigation pad then press the left soft key to choose **Done**.
6. Select **Hands-free** then press in on the trackwheel.
7. Press the **left soft key** to choose **Add**.

NOTE: Refer to your [Bluetooth Headset Pairing Guide](#) and begin headset instructions.

8. Press the **left soft key** to choose **Search**.
9. Press the **left soft key** to choose **Select**.
10. Enter the Passkey then press the **left soft key** to choose **Accept**. The typical default passkey is **0000 (four zeros)**.
11. Press the **left soft key** to choose **Done**.

1. Turn the headset *on* by pressing **Answer/End** button.
2. Press the **Answer/End** button *and* the volume up (+) button at the same time, until a solid blue light comes on.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

1. Ensure headset is off.
2. Press/hold the answer/end button until you see a solid blue light (approx 3-8 seconds), then release.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

1. Ensure headset is off.
2. Press the pairing button on the headset.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

Logitech Mobile Traveller™ SE

1. Ensure headset is off.
2. Press/hold the multi-function key until the LED light flashes red/blue. Release the multi-function key.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

1. Ensure headset is off and boom is closed.
2. Press/hold the multifunction button until you see a solid blue light (approx 3 seconds). Then release the button and immediately open the boom. (The headset indicator should remain on.)
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

1. Ensure headset is off.
2. Press/hold the Call button for about 8 seconds. The indicator light will initially flash; continue to hold until the indicator is steadily lit.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

Plantronics 320

1. Ensure headset is off.
2. Press/hold control button until indicator flashes blue/red.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

1. Ensure headset is off.
2. Press hold call control button and volume up (+) button at same time for about 2 seconds. Release buttons when indicator flashes blue/red.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

1. Ensure device is powered off.
2. Press and hold the “Multi-Function” button until you hear a high pitched tone in your ear.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

Bluetooth Hands Free Car Kit

1. Ensure hands free kit is powered on.
2. Press and hold the BlueTooth and Mute buttons for 3 seconds or until light begins flashing on kit.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

LG Bluetooth Portable Accessory

1. Ensure device is powered on.
2. Press and hold **CLR** button for 5 seconds.
3. Refer back to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

1. Ensure device is powered off.
2. Press and release the **Volume/Power** button and wait for LED light to remain on.
3. Refer to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

Motorola HT820 – Bluetooth Stereo Headphones

1. Make sure that your headphones are turned off.
 2. Press and hold the left side call button for 6 seconds until the indicator light turns on and remains steadily lit.
 3. Refer to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.
- Note: Currently only two devices support Bluetooth Stereo Headphones – the Motorola Q and the LG Chocolate. When the Handset pairing instructions for the Motorola Q appear, select Stereo Headset instead of Hands-free.

LG Bluetooth Lanyard Stereo Headset with In-Line Music Controller

1. Charge the Bluetooth® Stereo Headset for use.
 2. To activate pairing mode, press and hold PLAY/PAUSE/STOP for 5 seconds.
 - The LCD will display “PAIRING MODE”.
 3. Refer to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.
- Note: Currently only two devices support Bluetooth Stereo Headphones – the Motorola Q and the LG Chocolate. When the Handset pairing instructions for the Motorola Q appear, select Stereo Headset instead of Hands-free.

1. Fully charge headset – about 2 hours
2. Turn on the headset.
3. Press and hold the pairing button until you see a solid blue light.
4. Refer to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.

LG LBT710

1. With the LBT710 off, press and hold the PWR/END/Pairing Key for 5+ seconds.
2. Once you hear a short beep and the LED Status Indicator stays red, the device is in Pairing Mode.
3. Refer to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.



Jabra VBT135

1. Turn off the VBT135 by pressing the answer/end/pairing button until the blue LED light shows a burst of flashes.
2. Press and hold the answer/end/pairing button until you see a solid blue light. Headset is now discoverable.
3. Refer to [Handset Pairing Guide](#) for final instructions.
